

Turn your ideas into reality in Smallbridge & Firgrove Ward

Ambition for Ageing is a project working across a number of targeted wards in Greater Manchester. In Rochdale these are Central Rochdale, West Middleton and Smallbridge & Firgrove. Our aim is to improve the lives of older people (aged 50+) by finding out what is already good about where they live and what can be improved. By investing in small changes we hope to make places more 'age friendly' and improve the wellbeing and participation of older people in the community.

Ambition for Ageing will invest in good ideas to help make our communities better places to grow older in. There are local steering groups in each area which identify local priorities and consider the community investment applications.

The following needs have been identified for the Smallbridge & Firgrove area:

To make general improvements to the green spaces and tidy up of the Buckley View and Low Hill areas of Smallbridge. Your project needs to be sustainable so it can carry on after our funding ends; it should demonstrate continuity and preferably work with local schools and organisations in the area.
